 - In Dr. Nusse's presentation, *Research into the Links Between Embryogenesis and Cancer; How Cells Influence Each Other*, he walks attendees through key findings from his research career, including his pioneering work on the Wnt signalling pathway, which is an evolutionarily conserved pathway that regulates processes such as cell migration and cell polarity, and plays an important role in development, cancer and stem cells.
