If you are currently completing Grade 10, 11 or 12, looking for a summer job and are considering pursuing a career in the trades after high school; the Saskatchewan Youth Internship Program (SYIP) is for you!

- **Start date:** July 7, 2025
- **End date:** August 15, 2025. Some internships may be longer.
- **Apply by:** **Wednesday, April 16, 2025.** Send completed application package to the SIEC office

Steps if your application is successful:

1. You'll be contacted by SYIP staff
2. Interviews will be scheduled
3. If hired, you will be assigned a job coach to assist in job readiness and paperwork
4. Safety training will be scheduled and provided at no charge

Through the 2025 SYIP, you can apply for high school Apprenticeship credits that count towards high school graduation. To choose this option, make sure to indicate on your application.
